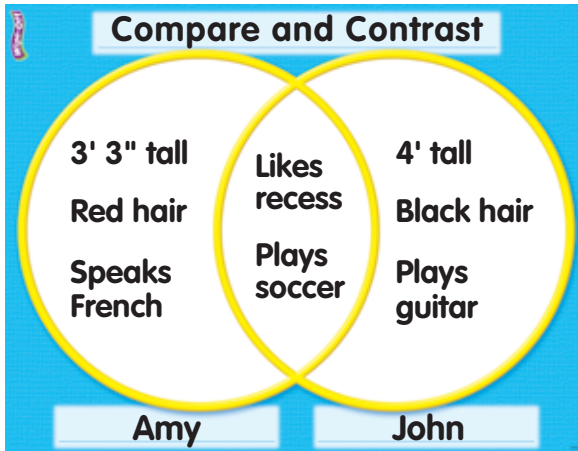

Subject: Language Arts

Learning Objectives: Demonstrate an understanding of comparisons and practice descriptive language.

Display the pieces as shown along with a Venn Diagram Wipe-Off® Chart.

Ask questions about the monkey and giraffe from the set: heights, habits, things they may like. Plot answers on the diagram showing how the two animals are alike and different.

As a class, come up with four or five getting-to-know-you questions. Divide into interview pairs and write each other's answers on accent backs.

Students write their names on accent fronts and place them in an envelope. Take turns drawing out two names and reading their answers out loud. Discuss how the pair are similar or different. Volunteers write similarities and differences on the diagram.

For each round, invite one student to determine if their classmates are alike or different, and then say a sentence describing how. Kids will celebrate similarities and differences, and practice vocabulary too!
