Subjects: Language Arts and Social Studies
Learning Objectives: Practice reading and introduce setting and achieving goals.
 Use colored paper to create a race track and display the set pieces as shown.
 Invite students on a reading road trip! They each select a race car, write their name on it, and add it to the display.
 Each student answers reading goal questions, for example:

- How many books can I read at home in 1 week, 2 weeks, 3?
- How many books can we read as a class in 1 month, 2 months?

Set a class reading goal and decide how long the class has to meet this goal. Each student will set an individual goal that will contribute to the class total. Write their goals on their cars.
 Explain how creating a plan can help you reach your goals. Together, everyone decides the steps needed to meet the class and individual goals. Write these steps on paper and post on the display. Celebrate success as students reach the finish line!
