Variety is the spice of life, especially when it comes to apples. Your students will enjoy counting, matching, and patterning with six varieties of apples. Design a cookie sheet of delicious fun with a basketful of special apples and a few stickers and trimmers ... magnetized!

Cookie Sheet Helpful Hints:

- Change magnetic pieces daily or weekly.
- Use colorful stars to mark position on cookie sheet for each activity.
- Sort games in envelopes for storage.
- Use back of cookie sheet for alternate-themed games.
- Use magnetic strips with game pieces. Purchase magnetic material in sheets and cut to dimensions needed.
- Purchase magnetic adhesive sheets to make it easier to adhere to game pieces.



Awesome Apples

You'll Need:

- T-92319 Jazzy Gems Terrific Trimmers®**
- T-91320 Gold Terrific Trimmers®**
- T-10834 Apples Mini Accents Variety Pack**
- T-46405 Colorful Sparkle Stars superShapes Stickers**
- T-1780 Red 1" STICK-EZE® Stick-On Letters**

Cookie sheet, magnetic adhesive sheets, tagboard or cardboard, 8½" x 11" envelope, double-sided tape, scissors.

Directions:

Cut two 11" x ¼" and two 10" x ½" magnetic strips for trimmers. Cut trimmers to size and adhere magnetic strips to backs. Use these trimmer strips as needed for game board. Cut magnetic strips and attach to the backs of the

apple accents. Use all six apple varieties from the pack. For subtitles, cut three tagboard pieces to ¾" x 1½". Attach magnetic adhesive to back of cardboard. Hand write three subtitles and attach them to tops of tagboard with tape.

For title, cut two trimmers to size of cookie sheet. Overlap trimmers and attach stick-on letters for your title. Back title with cardboard and magnetic adhesive. Cut Jazzy Gems trimmer and magnetic adhesive to 10" for wave. Back trimmer with magnetic adhesive of the same size.

Use the same materials for sorting and patterning play; however, for the patterning game, hand write "Match the Pattern" on an apple accent and add to game title.
