

# Learning **FUN!** Activity



The Bake Sale is open for business! This activity is a great way for students to practice math skills like counting, recognizing money, and making change. Students take turns being the baker and the buyer.

## Bake Sale Cupcakes

### You'll Need:

- T-10979 Bake Shop™ Cupcakes**  
*Classic Accents® Variety Pack*
- T-10858 Bake Shop™ Cupcakes**  
*Mini Accents Variety Pack*

A baker's box, construction or wrapping paper, a craft stick, glue or tape, foam core, a marker, and paper crinkle shreds.

### Directions:

Cover a baker's box with construction or wrapping paper. On a Bake Shop™ Cupcakes Classic Accents®, write down the price of one cupcake, in this case, 25 cents. Glue or tape the accent to a craft stick. Place the larger price tag cupcake where it's easy to see. Cut triangle shape easels from foam core and attach to the backs of Bake Shop™ Cupcakes Mini Accents. Stack rows of foam core in the base of the box at graduated heights to form tiers so all cupcakes can be seen inside the box. After adding cupcakes, fill in the base of the box with paper crinkle shreds. Inside the top cover of the baker's box, create a sign with pricing, "2 for \$0.50, 4 for \$1.00, 6 for \$1.50" and the title "Bake Sale."
