



# Learning FUN! Activity

Keep track of student birthdays with a handy Birthday Wheel! A turn of the wheel reveals the monthly birthdays and allows plenty of time to prepare special events and activities for the noted days. Use this activity as an opportunity to review the dates and months of the year with the class.



## Birthday Wheel

### You'll Need:

**T-1785** Black 1" STICK-EZE® Stick-On Letters

**T-10979** Bake Shop™ Cupcakes  
Classic Accents® Variety Pack

**T-10970** Candle Brights  
Classic Accents® Variety Pack

Heavy construction paper or card stock, a ruler, a marker, a brass fastener, a compass, and scissors.

### Directions:

Cut out two 18" circles from heavy construction paper or card stock. On one circle, draw a wedge that is 1/12<sup>th</sup> the size of the circle and cut the wedge out (Fig. 1). On the other circle, divide and draw 12 equal wedges; then draw a series of concentric circles (Fig.2). On this circle, write the names of the months

along the top ring of the lined wheel – one month per wedge. Attach the circle with the wedge cut out onto the top of the lined circle with a brass fastener secured in the middle. Write each student's name and birthdate under the appropriate month inside the grid formed by the concentric circles. Title your creation, "Birthday Wheel" with STICK-EZE® Stick-On Letters, and decorate it with Bake Shop™ Cupcakes and Candle Brights Classic Accents®.
