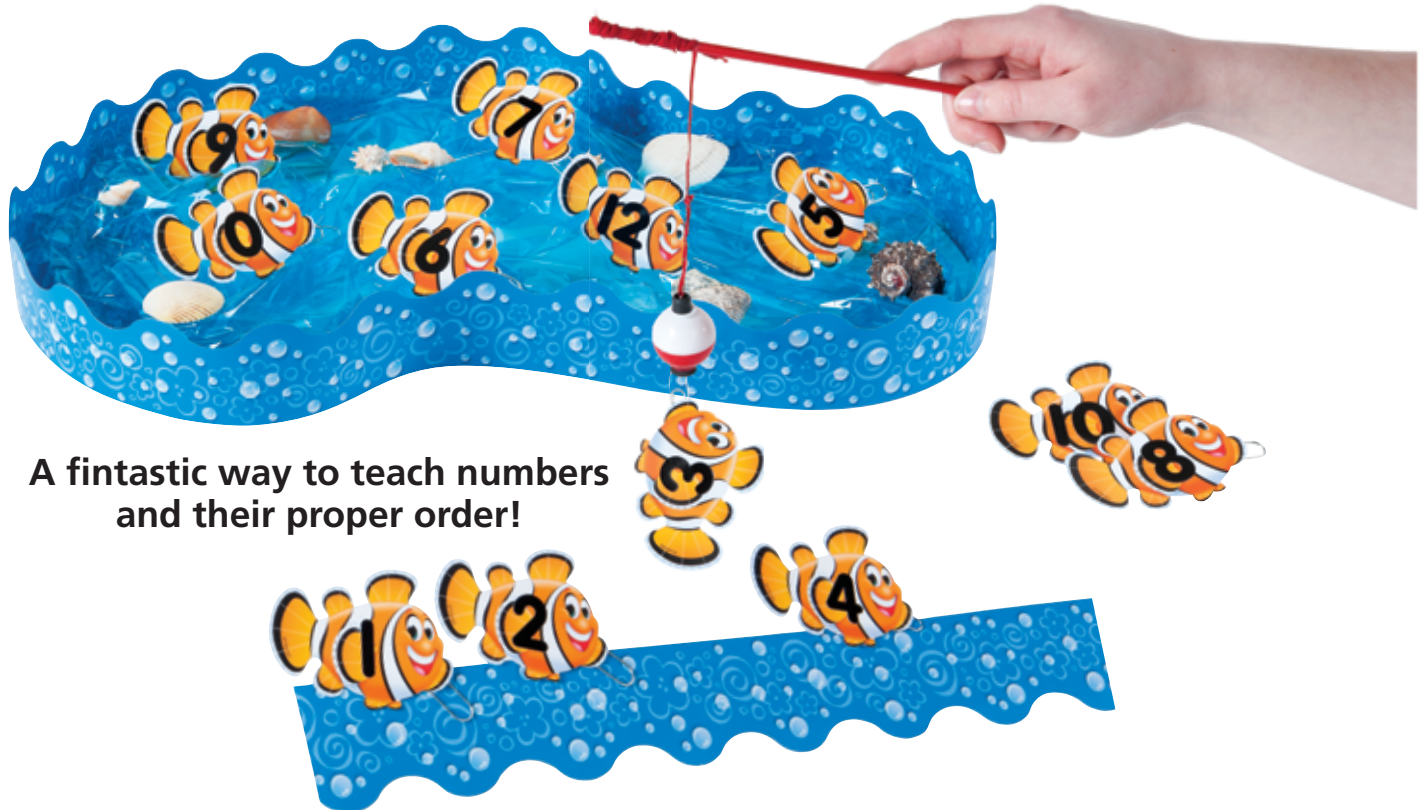

Fishing for Numbers



Teacher-Made Activity

Invite kids to cast into a pond stocked with friendly fish and numbers.

You'll Need:

- T10592** Sea Buddies™ Mini Accents
- T92860** Blue Splash Terrific Trimmers®
- T1785** Black 1" Letters, Numbers, & Marks
STICK-EZE® Stick-On Letters

Blue cellophane, hot glue, foam core, seashells, double-sided tape, paper clips, circular magnets, fishing bobber, a dowel, and string

Directions:

- Cut foam core into the shape of a pond, and line the top with crinkled cellophane. Tape trimmers

back-to-back and wrap around the pond's edge, securing with double-sided tape.

- Make a fishing pole by tying string to the end of the dowel rod. Glue a magnet to the bobber and fasten to the end of the string.
- Attach a STICK-EZE® number and a paper clip to each fish. Add fish, along with shells, to the pond.
- Ask kids to take turns fishing, and challenge them to display the catch of the day – in number order – on a trimmer.

Make It Your Own:

Our game has kids fishing for numbers, but you can have them fish for sight words, blends, words that rhyme, and more!
