Unfold a world of wisdom with fancy folding books! Learning is all the more fun with whimsical books filled with fun facts or in a question-and-answer format. Multiple panels give children the opportunity to fill the books with interesting facts, photos, and drawings.



Fun Folding Book

You'll Need:

- T-10587 Owl-Stars!™ Mini Accents**
- T-10535 Shiny Red Apple Mini Accents**

Construction paper, scissors, a marker, and glue or tape.

Optional: ribbon.

Directions:

Cut construction paper into 6-inch squares. This book uses 4 squares, but yours can be larger or smaller. Fold each square in half horizontally as

shown in Fig. 1, and unfold it. Fold the square in half vertically as shown in Fig. 2, and unfold it again. Flip the square over, and fold it in half diagonally once, as shown in Fig. 3. Poke in corners A and B, as shown in Fig. 4. After folding all squares for your book, line up the squares, alternating which side is up. Do this by finding point C, as shown in Fig. 4. Overlap the folded squares, and glue them together, as shown in Fig. 5. Within the book, decorate the panels with Owl-Stars!™ or Shiny Red Apple Mini Accents. On other panels, write facts or questions and answers about owls or apples. For a fun, final touch, use a pretty ribbon to tie the book closed when it is folded up.

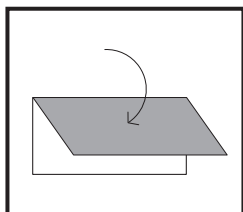

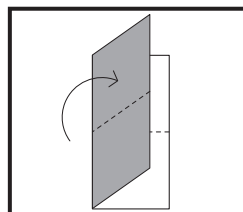

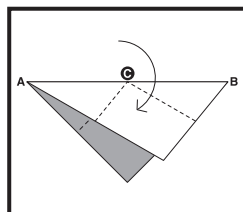

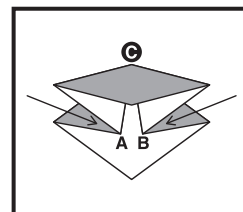
