Another fall day in the neighborhood ... with a friendly fence of class names, complete with colorful leaves. Everyone will want to visit your fun-filled, class-sized fence. Welcome to the neighborhood!

Neighborhood Leaf Fences

You'll Need:

T-10836 Maple Leaves *Mini Accents Variety Pack*

T-80011 Grass *Terrific Trimmers® – Discovery*

T-68035 Lively Leaves *Name Tags*

T-37006 Alphabet Fun *Foil Bright Stickers*

Popsicle sticks or tongue depressors, grid paper (optional), glue, double-sided tape, scissors.

Directions:

Individual fence sections – Build as many fence sections as needed. Glue two horizontal sticks to the back of six vertical sticks. Allow to dry. Then glue grass trimmer and leaf accent to fence as shown. Ask each student to use alphabet stickers to put their name on a fence piece, downward on one post. Make an easel stand for each section for dimension.

Gatekeeper's fence section – Use five sticks for vertical posts, positioning them to create an arch as shown (use grid paper to help align them). Glue and wait until dry. Then glue three sticks vertically in the center so they align with the bottom of other sticks. Glue two horizontal sticks to the back of the vertical sticks as shown. Allow to dry.

Write class name on name tag and glue to front.
