These delightful leaf people bring fall colors to life and smiles to students. Have your children make one of their own and give it a name. Watch them get creative when working with clay. Each leaf person will be as unique as the child who designed it!

Little Leaf People

You'll Need:

- T-10813 Fall Leaves** *Mini Accents Variety Pack*
- T-46405 Colorful Sparkle Stars** *superShapes Stickers*

Toilet paper tubes, plastic wrap tubes, scissors, glue, 3-D craft eyes, colorful clay, twigs (or chenille stems), cardboard, colored construction paper.

Directions:

Glue construction paper around the tubes, using a different color for each tube. Cut round discs out of cardboard, just a little larger than the ends of the tubes. Then glue them on each end. (Use cardboard that will hold its shape and support the standing tubes.)

Glue leaves to tops of tubes, positioning them as the face for each tube. Use colored clay to shape mouths, noses, and other features you want on the leaf faces. Lay tubes on their side to glue on the eyes, clay facial features, and star stickers for buttons. Allow each piece to dry completely.

Poke small holes on opposite sides of each tube (about 2" down the tubes) and place the twigs in the holes, positioning them as the arms of your Little Leaf People.
