Magnetic Math



Teacher-Made Activity

Use magnetic manipulatives to build math skills.

You'll Need:

T10653 Silly Squirrels Classic Accents® Variety Pack

T46036 Numbers superShapes Stickers

Colored paper, double stick tape, baking sheet, and adhesive magnets

Directions:

Create a magnetic math center to give early learners a visual, hands-on way to practice math basics and count using objects.

- Attach colored paper to the back of a baking sheet.
- Write math equations on the log accents using numbers and symbols in the superShapes Stickers pack. Add adhesive magnets to the back of each log, squirrel, and acorn.
- Invite children to use the acorns to count out each number and solve the problems. This activity works great as individual practice or to quiz each other in partners.

Make It Your Own:

Make the activity a group challenge by using two baking sheets. One student counts and displays the first number in the equation and another counts and displays the second number, then solve for the answer as a class!
