Noun & Verb Sort



Teacher-Made Activity

Focus on learning nouns and verbs by sorting words.

You'll Need:

- T10989 Awesome Animals Classic Accents® Variety Pack
 - T68046 Pixels Terrific Labels™
 - T85342 Pixels Bolder Borders®
 - T10859 Paw Prints Mini Accents Variety Pack
- Boxes, black marker, double-sided tape, and scissors

Directions:

Create a sorting activity to help kids learn to identify parts of speech.

- Tape a length of border around three boxes. Attach animal accents to the boxes as shown, and label each: "words," "nouns," or "verbs."
- Write an equal number of nouns and verbs on the Paw Prints accents. Place all accents in the "words" box to start.
- Each child draws an accent from the "words" box, identifies the word, then places it into the correct box.

Great for individual practice or playing with one or more friends! Time the activity for an added challenge.

Make It Your Own:

Once you are done sorting, take turns choosing a verb or noun accent and using it in a sentence.
