Owl Praise



Teacher-Directed Activity

Kids present praise words to each other, then create a spirited display.

You'll Need:

T10652 Bright Owls Classic Accents® Variety Pack
T10896 Praise Words Mini Accents Variety Pack
Twigs or branches, toothpicks, glue, tape, and markers

Directions:

Build positivity with this esteem-building activity.

- Each child writes her/his name on a log accent and places it in a container. Then students draw a name.
- Children tell each other about recent projects, recitals, or presentations that made them especially proud.

- Each child wishes their classmate a job well done by writing a hooray message and what makes that classmate special on the back. Tape accents to toothpicks and attach to colorful owls.
- Children take turns reading the sentiments and presenting the owls to each other in front of the class.
- After the praise-worthy presentations, attach the owls to long twigs or branches as bright and friendly focal points for the class!

A great way to remind kids they are owl-mazing and boost classroom community spirit too!

Make It Your Own:

Invite students to write acrostic poems using each other's names and hang the poems from the logs. Kids will hoot seeing a display made especially for them.
