

Learning FUN! Activity



Promote classroom serenity with peace sign garland or necklaces. This fun activity provides children the opportunity to fine tune their motor skills and work on patterning as they string the peace signs and straws onto the yarn. While working, engage the class in a discussion about peaceful behavior.



Peace Signs Garland-Necklaces

You'll Need:

- T-10856 Peace Signs (Solids)**
Mini Accents Variety Pack
- T-10878 Peace Signs (Patterns)**
Mini Accents Variety Pack

Drinking straws, scissors, a hole punch, and yarn.

Directions:

Glue two Peace Signs Solids and/or Patterns Mini Accents together, back to back. Use a hole punch to make holes either in the middle or on each side of the Peace Signs Mini Accents. Cut drinking straws into equal, desired lengths. Using a very long piece of yarn for garland, or smaller pieces for necklaces, thread the yarn through the peace signs and then the straw pieces, alternating back and forth between the two. For garland, knot each end and display in the classroom. For necklaces, knot the two ends of the yarn together.
