You'll Need:

Small wood dowels, colored construction paper, printer paper, multicolored pencil tip erasers, florist foam, glue, crinkle paper shreds, a large potato chip can for main flag holder, and several smaller cans for students' desks.

Note: For this activity, positive messages were taken from the TREND Healthy Habits (T49902) and Getting Along (T49903) Look & Learn[®] Poster Packs.

Directions:

Flags: Glue erasers on the tips of wooden dowels (hot glue works best). Cut wavy flag shapes out of the trimmers, leaving an extra inch to attach to the flagpoles (wood dowels). Type and print positive messages and glue them to the front of each flag. Wrap each flag around a dowel, adhering it with glue.

Flag Holders: Cut cans down to desired size, a large one to hold the Praise Flags and smaller ones for each child's desk. Decorate cans with colored construction paper and label with a name tag. Add florist foam to the bottom of each can and insert the flagpoles. Add crinkled paper shreds for a fun, festive look!
