★ Featured Display: Can-Do Doll

Create an irresistible display that models and celebrates significant learning achievements. Begin with a sheet of cardboard about 2' wide x 3' tall. Draw and cut out a paper-doll-style child. Dress with fabric swatches or construction paper. Add felt or yarn hair and paper or button eyes. Glue buttons and a zipper to the shirt and pants, and add shoelaces (or yarn) to the shoes. Secure the doll to your display and surround it with the bulletin board set pieces. You can enhance the display with more objects to represent the skills, such as paper dolls, alphabet cards, and name plates with student-printed names. Children will delight in this new little "friend" as they practice and master important new skills!
