Activity

Bake up a batch of fun for students with a game of Tic-Tac-Toe! They'll love the star and apple playing pieces, along with the colorful trim and stickers. What's the attraction? It's a cheery and creative way to play the game on a cookie sheet with great connections!



Cookie Sheet Helpful Hints:

- Change magnetic pieces daily or weekly.
- Use colorful stars to mark position on cookie sheet for each activity.
- Sort games in envelopes for storage.
- Use back of cookie sheet for alternate-themed games.
- Use magnetic strips with game pieces. Purchase magnetic material in sheets and cut to dimensions needed.
- Purchase magnetic adhesive sheets to make it easier to adhere to game pieces.

TIC-TAC-TOE

You'll Need:

- T-92319 Jazzy Gems Terrific Trimmers®**
- T-91320 Gold Terrific Trimmers®**
- T-10535 Shiny Red Apple Mini Accents**
- T-10589 Smiley Star Mini Accents**
- T-46405 Colorful Sparkle Stars superShapes Stickers**
- T-1780 Red 1" STICK-EZE® Stick-On Letters**

Cookie sheet, magnetic adhesive sheets, tagboard or cardboard, 8½" x 11" envelope, double-sided tape, scissors.

Directions:

Cut four 11" x ¼" magnetic strips for trimmers. Cut trimmers to size and adhere magnetic strips to backs. Place two magnetic strips across and two down on cookie sheet for game board. Cut 10 magnetic strips and attach to the backs of the accents.

For game title, cut trimmer to width of cookie sheet. Add game title to trimmer using stick-on letters. Back trimmer with cardboard; then attach magnetic adhesive strips. Place on top of cookie sheet (game board). Use envelope to store playing pieces.

Have fun playing tic-tac-toe with apples and stars.
