Missing a few vowels? Your children will enjoy finding them and completing the words with a crafty clip.

Imagine their surprise when they discover two or more vowels that complete a word ... fin, fan, FUN!



## Vowel Fun

### You'll Need:

- T11435** **Stargazer Terrific Papers®**
- T10864** **Stargazer Mini Accents Variety Pack**
- T4011** **12" Multicolor Wipe-Off® Phrase Strips**
- T98003** **4-Pack Standard Colors Wipe-Off® Markers**

Small cereal or cardboard box, wooden clothespins, small white paper squares, multicolored tissue paper, glue or double-sided tape, and hook-and-loop dots.

### Directions:

Decorate a small box with Terrific Papers® and Mini Accents. Attach a phrase strip to front of box with the title "Vowel Fun" adhered to it as shown.

Write vowel practice words on Wipe-Off® Phrase Strips, leaving a blank space for the vowel. Write vowels on small squares of white paper, one per square, making sure you have all the vowels. Adhere each vowel to a clothespin using hook-and-loop dots.

Place all word strips in the decorated box and clip the vowel clothespins to the rim of the box. Then it's time for some vowel fun!
